## Gold Medal for Lawrenny

The 2018 Australian Distilled Spirits Awards (ADSA) have been awarded in Melbourne with local Tasmanian distiller Lawrenny Estate taking home Gold for their Van Diemen's Gin, a Silver medal for their 1818 Settlers Gin and a Bronze medal for their St Clair Vodka.

"This is a real validation of the quality of products that our Head Distiller has created, standing up in a field of exceptional entries from across Australia" commented company General Manager Jensen Farley

"Each of the Lawrenny products have been developed to reflect an element of the historic Estate. The Gold medal winning Van Diemen's Gin is a reflection of spring time on the estate with fresh citrus, vanilla and fennel whilst the Settlers Gin is more robust and is a reflection of the colonial pioneers containing a smokiness extracted from brown cardamom. The St Clair Vodka represents the pure waters that run through the Estate, combined with botanicals found in the gardens."

"To achieve these results in our first year of operation is a significant achievement for our business. This is a nice reward for our small team that has worked extremely hard to bring these products to market."

This year's Australian Distilled Spirits Awards attracted a record 295 entries this year, a 20% increase on 2017, reflecting the burgeoning industry and increasing number of distillers across the country. Entries were assessed by 16 of Australia's leading industry experts over two days, with points awarded for appearance, nose, palate, balance and finish.
